Instructions For Use

NOTE: In cold weather, warm "Unipak" container to 40°F (4°C) or warmer before mixing. Keep in a warm area, such as truck cab or inside pocket, until ready to use.

Step 1 – Remove "Unipak" container from this envelope.

Step 2 – Firmly grasp each side of bag near center barrier. Pull apart by rolling thumbs through the full length of the center barrier.



Step 3 – Mix by alternately squeezing the ends of bag, forcing encapsulant rapidly back and forth. Complete 10 to 20 vigorous squeezes (1 minute).



Step 4 – Strip encapsulant from corners of the "UNIPAK" container between fingers.



Step 5 – Complete mixing with an additional 20 to 30 vigorous squeezes (2 minutes).



Step 6 – Clip off corner of "UNIPAK" container and pour encapsulant immediately after mixing.
